

## Using Scripture in the Weekly RCIA Meeting

### Lectionary-Based RCIA Method

This is a suggested model for tying the Sunday Readings to themes a group might wish to explore in RCIA.

Example:      Year A (*all texts from Matthew's gospel unless noted*)

Easter 5	John 14: 1-12	The Way, Truth & Life	<i>Getting Involved; Living Faith; The Way of Perfection</i>

Easter 6	John 14: 15-21	Promise of the Spirit	<i>Holy Spirit; Confirmation; Faith as Attitude; Prayer</i>
Easter 7	John 17: 1-11	Jesus' Priestly Prayer	<i>Prayer; Priesthood; Reviewing the RCIA Journey;</i>
Pentecost	John 20:19-23	Easter Appearance	<i>Holy Spirit; Baptism &amp; Confirmation; Sacraments; Mission</i>

*Although many Sundays may fall outwith the period a parish RCIA group might meet (after Pentecost but then over the summer break), there may be a case for continuing some kind of (whole-parish?) Sunday gospel reflection, along the lines of the RCIA meeting. It may prove helpful for those who chose not to enter the church at Easter, or as a continued reflection for neophytes – or indeed anyone in the parish!*
